Visit one of the friendly, family run farm shops dotted all the way along the coast for a unique shopping experience that's fun and educational too. Stock up on the freshest, locally sourced food perfect for a picnic or gifts for friends and family. Open all year, the only thing you need to do is check the opening hours before you set off along the coast.

**Westcroft Farm Shop & Nursery**, Berrow, family run business that has been serving delicious Somerset produce for over 40 years. They also have a garden nursery – selling plants, pots, compost and all garden sundries



**Rich's Cider Farm** Nr Highbridge, take pride in providing high quality, local and sustainable products at a fair price. They work only with businesses who care as much about the local area as they do to ensure customers get the best that Somerset has to offer; also tastings, tours of the cider farm and a restaurant

**Peasey Farm shop**, Nr Bridgwater, is a third-generation family run farm with a unique farm shop selling home reared meat and local produce, hot and cold food from the Pit Stop, and a picnic area

**Clayhill Farm Shop**, Nr Spaxton, this small shop offers a variety of fresh farm produce and specialises in Lamb, Pork and Honey, but offer customers much more.
